

**Aspen Grove Church Planting Network**

**Aspen Grove Church Planting Network** exists to proactively catalyze, resource, and strengthen the successful planting of healthy, gospel-centered, reproducing communities of faith in the Presbytery of the West. We cultivate new churches through partnering with existing churches by recruiting, equipping, and caring for church planters and church plants. We plant churches in the major cities and cultural centers of the mountain west and those churches in turn cultivate church planting in that region, thus creating clusters of church planting churches or mini-networks in each region.

**Qualifications:** Ordained or able to be ordained in the Presbytery of the West, EPC, as a Ruling Elder or a Teaching Elder. Previous successful church planting experience expected.

**Remuneration:** Salary is \$30,000 annually for 20 hours per week.

Along with the AGCPN Executive Committee the Director will:

- Catalyze and resource existing churches of the POW into a church planting movement.  

Our goal as an organization and a denomination is to enable every church in the POW to become a Partner, Patron, or Parent Church in the AGCPN church planting movement.
- Further develop a church planting vision in the POW.
- Promote healthy church planting in the Presbytery of the West and the western United States.
- Maintain a growing knowledge and awareness of the changing state of church planting in the western United States.
- Build a pipeline of potential church planters by recruiting potential planters from colleges, seminaries, and other sources.
- Direct the yearly AGCPN Assessment Center:
  - Recruit potential planters.
  - Recruit and train church planting assessors.
  - Retain a distinct gospel atmosphere in the assessment.
  - Work with Steve Hill, the AGCPN assessment administrator.
- Consult with and coach existing churches of the POW in their church planting work.  

Promote church planting as the most effective biblical method for reaching new people for Christ.

Provide training on best church planting practices.  
Provide coaching and mentoring for pastors and church planters.

- Administrate the regular activities of the AGCPN.

Maintain an active office.

Supervise the AGCPN bookkeeper.

Monitor the AGCPN website and social media entities.

Recruit and mentor volunteers to further the ministry of the network.

Communicate with current plants and planters.

- Moderate the Executive Board of AGCPN.

- Serve on the General Council of the POW.

We understand that the Director may need to delegate the above items of this position description as necessary to other members of the Aspen Grove Church Planting Network Board.
