Dear Aspen Grove Church Partner and Supporter,

Currently there are over thirty new church plants in the EPC. People are hearing the good news of Christ in many new places! Aspen Grove Church Planting Network has played a significant part in that mission project. As a Partner or Patron Church of Aspen Grove Church Planting Network you have too. We have contributed significantly to eighteen of those plants. We have been a part of church plants in various stages from Englewood to Durango to Denver to Winter Park to Detroit to Youngstown, OH. We have assessed nearly twenty church planters, including three of our first African American planters. We have contributed greatly to the church planting cause in the POW and the EPC. Our vision and leadership is a model for other EPC Presbyteries. May God give to your church as generously as you have given!

At the last Presbytery Meeting, Eugene Scott, announced his resignation from his position as the Executive Director of Aspen Grove and moved back into the pastorate as the Executive Pastor of Wellspring Church. This is a decision that Eugene prayerfully considered and kept our team well informed of over the course of the fall. As a result the board has been able to proactively plan and lay the groundwork in this season.

What will happen to Aspen Grove Church Planting Network? We will continue our crucial work and our active planning for the future.

Therefore, we are asking you to renew your commitment to being a part of God's kingdom work through AGCPN. Since I informed our board of directors, representing some of our strongest churches, they have been meeting regularly to plan out the future and ensure that we continue to build upon the foundation that was already started.

The Executive Board is actively meeting and planning the next steps of the Aspen Grove Church Planting Network. In the last month, the board has reached out to all planting churches, formed a search team for our new director, and are currently pursuing candidates to plant, Gospel Centered, Multiplying Churches in our region and beyond! In addition, we are continuing to support a parish church in Englewood, coaching and training a missional group in Winter Park, consulting and preparing for a church planter in Phoenix, and strengthening the work of a bi-vocational work in Durango, Colorado. God is on the move with church planting. These are our heroes and we are so grateful for your support of their work!
