- 1) Membership for at least six months in EPC church
- 2) Endorsement by session of that church
- 3) Following paperwork sent to Care of Candidates Committee
- -Application to Come Under Care
- -Session Endorsement Form
- -Personal Information Form
- -Preliminary Questionnaire
- -College Transcripts
- 4) Care of Candidates Committee Interview
- -Sharing conversion to Christ and growth in Christian life
- -Sharing call to Christian ministry
- -Discussing motive for seeking EPC ordination
- 5) Presbytery of the West Interview
- -Sharing and discussing the same topics on the floor of Presbytery and being assigned an adviser

Ordination:

- 1) Complete one year as Candidate Under Care
- 2) Following paperwork sent to Care of Candidates Committee
- -Physical evaluation
- -MMPI-2 psychological evaluation
- -Background check
- -MDiv or equivalent transcript (if necessary, equivalency work may be assigned)
- 3) Completion of Discovery Workshop
- 4) Call and Terms of Call approved
- 5) Completion of the following written EPC Ordination Exams
- -English Bible
- -Theology, Sacraments, and Reformed Tradition
- -Polity
- -Biblical Hebrew and Greek Exegesis Paper
- 6) Completion of Statements of Faith and Exceptions to WCF & C's
- 7) Examination before Care of Candidates Committee
- 8) Sermon and Exam before the Presbytery of the West along with requisite installation preparations
